



MANUAL OF GOOD ENVIRONMENTAL PRACTICES

The sporting event “ELECTRÓN FUERTEBIKE” takes place within a protected area of the Red Natura 2000, specifically in the Special Area of Conservation for Birds ZEPA, Vallebrón and the valleys of Fimapaire and Fenimoy.

This is one of the best areas on the island for the Canary stonechat (*Saxicola dacotiae dacotiae*) and also highlights the presence of the Canary houbara bustard (*Chlamydotis undulata fuertaventurae*), an endemic species of the island of Fuerteventura and currently listed as endangered, the major hawk (*Pernopterus majorensis*), the Canary falcon (*Falco peregrinus pelegrinoides*), the Barbary partridge (*Alectoris barbara koenigi*) and the trumpeter finch (*Rhodopechys githaginea amantum*).

Altering the landscape and natural conditions of an area only contributes to its degradation and the loss of biodiversity.

It is necessary that you follow these guidelines to avoid any negative impact on birdlife and the natural values of the areas through which the race route passes:

- Walk and/or ride on the existing trails. Do not cut across fields or leave the established route.
- Respect plants, animals, rocks, and historical remains. Do not trample vegetation.
- Avoid unnecessary noise and disturbing wildlife. Do not feed wild animals (squirrels, crows, etc.).
- Do not leave any waste you generate in the natural environment. Dispose of it in the designated recycling containers located at the aid stations along the route or at the finish line.
- Do not collect any natural elements during the event.
